### **Recycling Resources**

Use these resources to explore recycling opportunities for GAF roofing material waste from your job site. All resources are nationwide, except where noted.

## Additional notes

- Polyiso: Broken, wet, or contaminated sheets are not recyclable and must be discarded.
- PVC/TPO: Only mechanically attached or ballasted membranes are eligible for recycling.
- Membranes must be clean and prepared according to the specifications of the recycler.
- Contact the specific recycler to determine how to prepare materials.
- Recycling programs and availability may vary by region and condition of material.
- This guide is for educational purposes only. Anyone wishing to recycle material must contact the associated vendors to get the most up-to-date information.
